SEBMF H1N1 Flu Vaccine Update

Update: November 2 – 6, 2009

Due to diminished supplies, our H1N1 Flu Clinics have been postponed until further notice. We expect additional supplies; please check our website for availability and upcoming dates.

It is expected that there will be enough 2009 H1N1 flu vaccine for anyone who chooses to get vaccinated. According to the CDC, the US federal government has procured 250 million doses of 2009 H1N1 flu vaccine. As you may have heard on the news, H1N1 vaccine manufacturers are working as fast as possible to produce enough vaccine and will ship out as it becomes available. The State Department of Public Health is responsible for allocation of the H1N1 vaccine in California.

To date, California has only received about 2 million doses, a small portion of its full H1N1 vaccine allocation. Like many other health care providers, Sutter East Bay Medical Foundation (SEBMF) has not yet received most of our H1N1 vaccine order. We have contacted the State Department of Public Health for an update on our order and have not received a timeline of when we will receive our order. Please be assured that we are exhausting all resources to obtain our vaccines as quickly as possible.
